is the Son of God.”

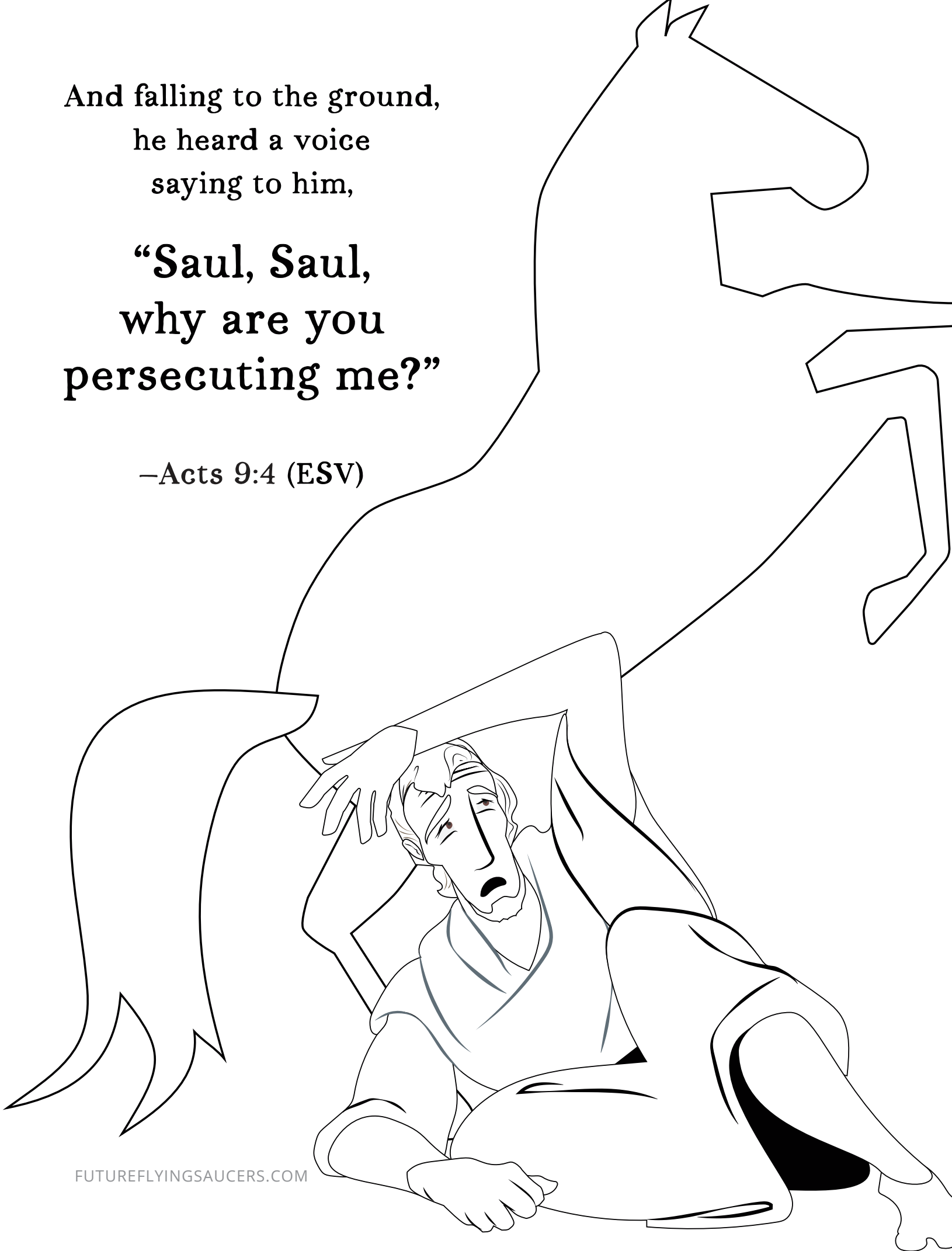

Then Peter realized what had happened.

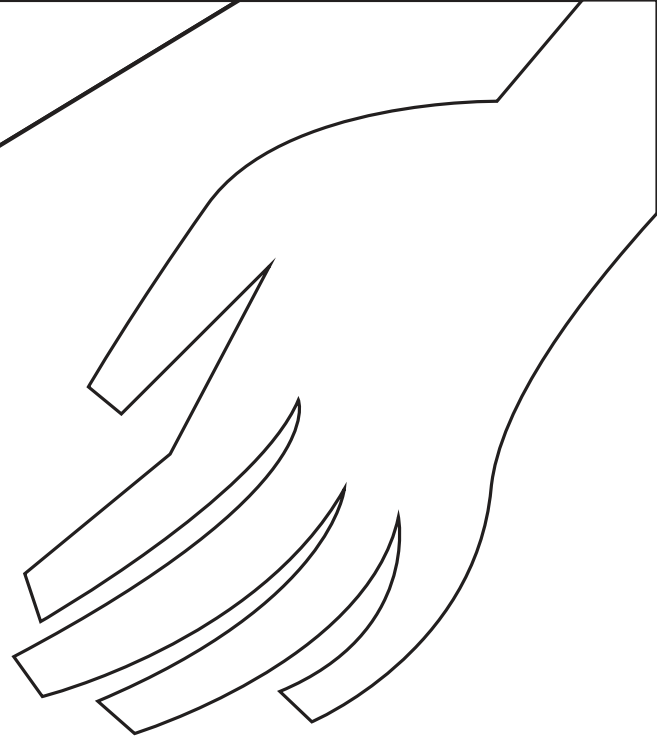

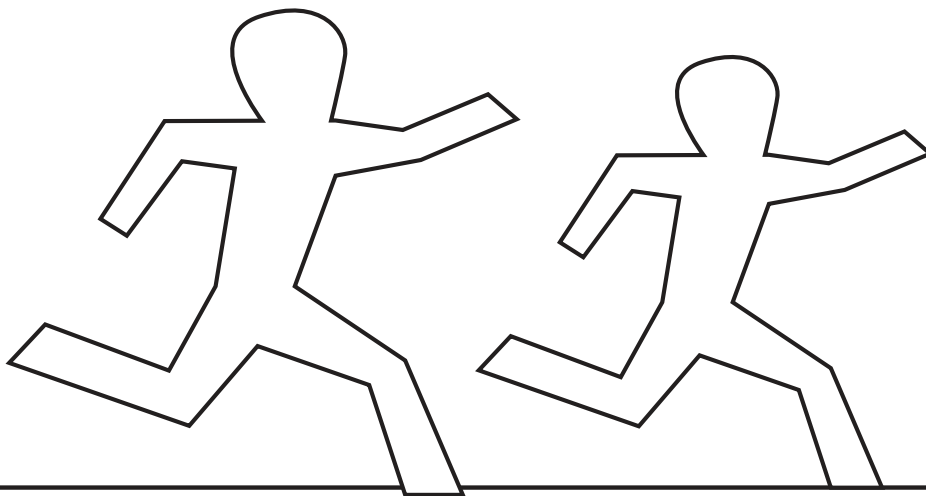




They were all worshipping the Lord

I have chosen them for it.”**

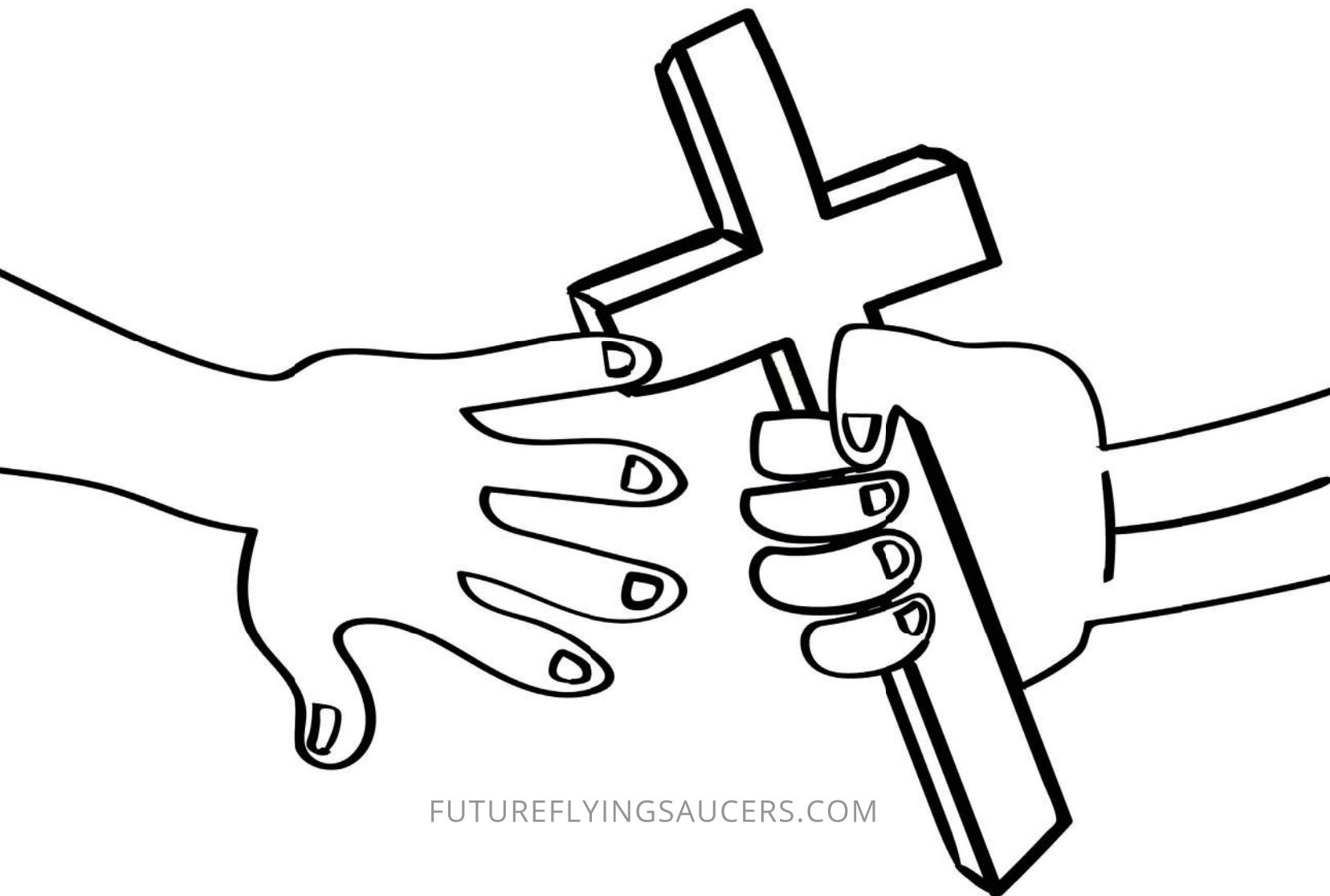

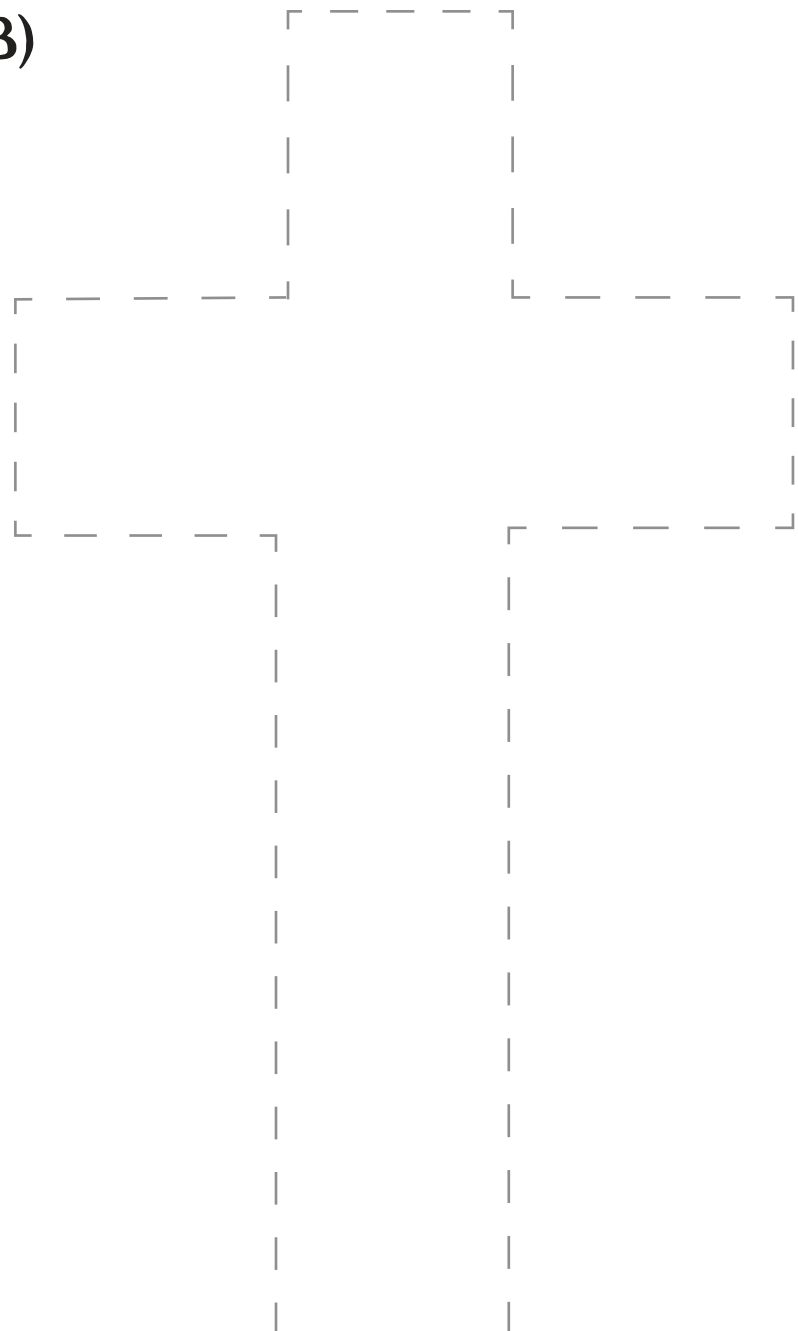


**Silas and Timothy came from

spreading and growing.

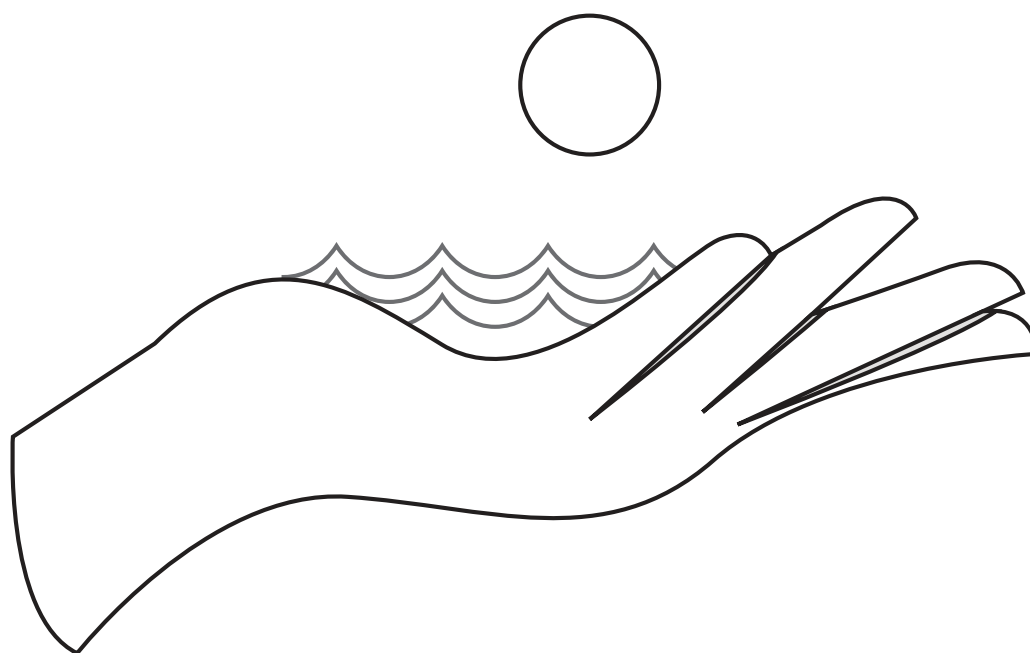

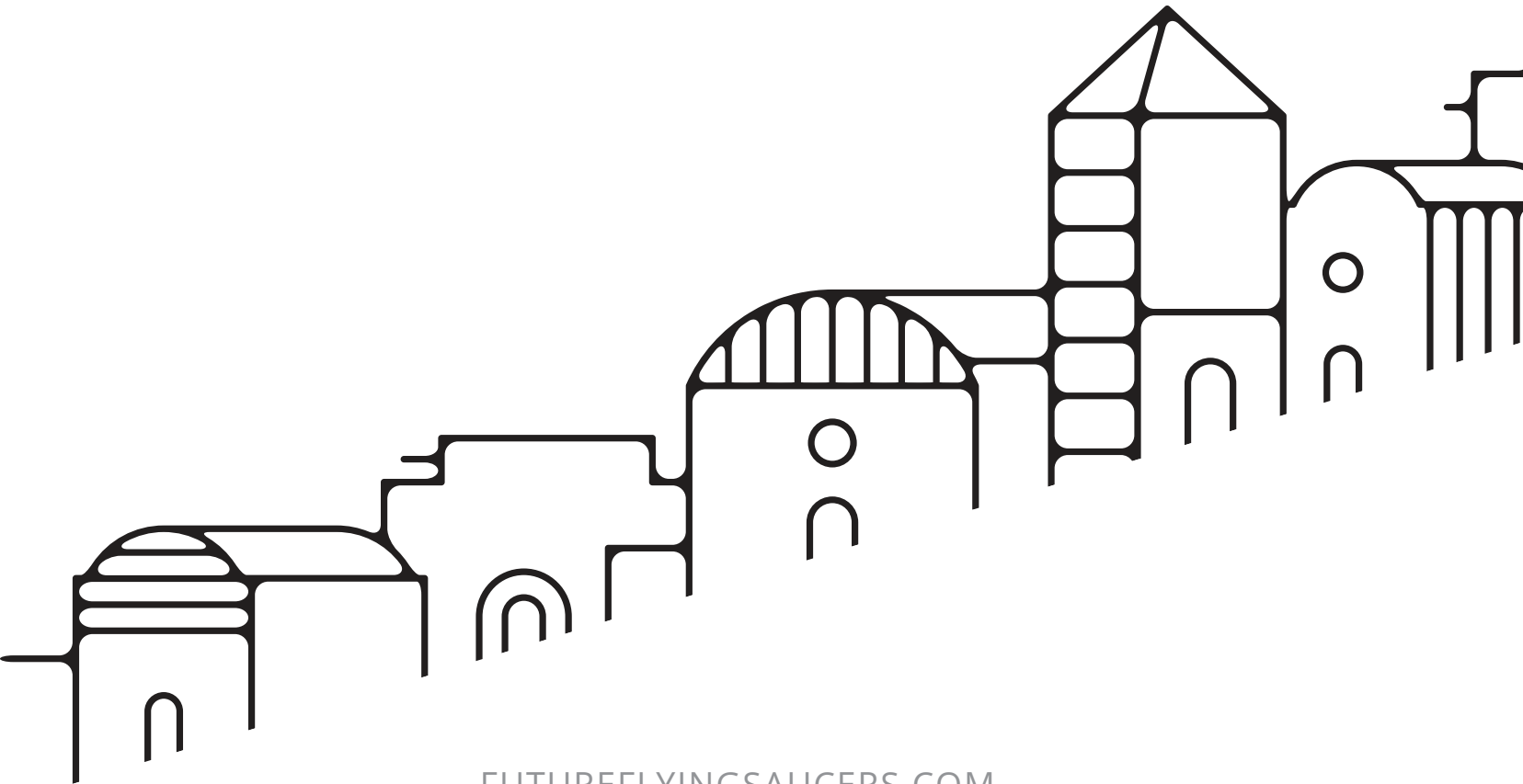

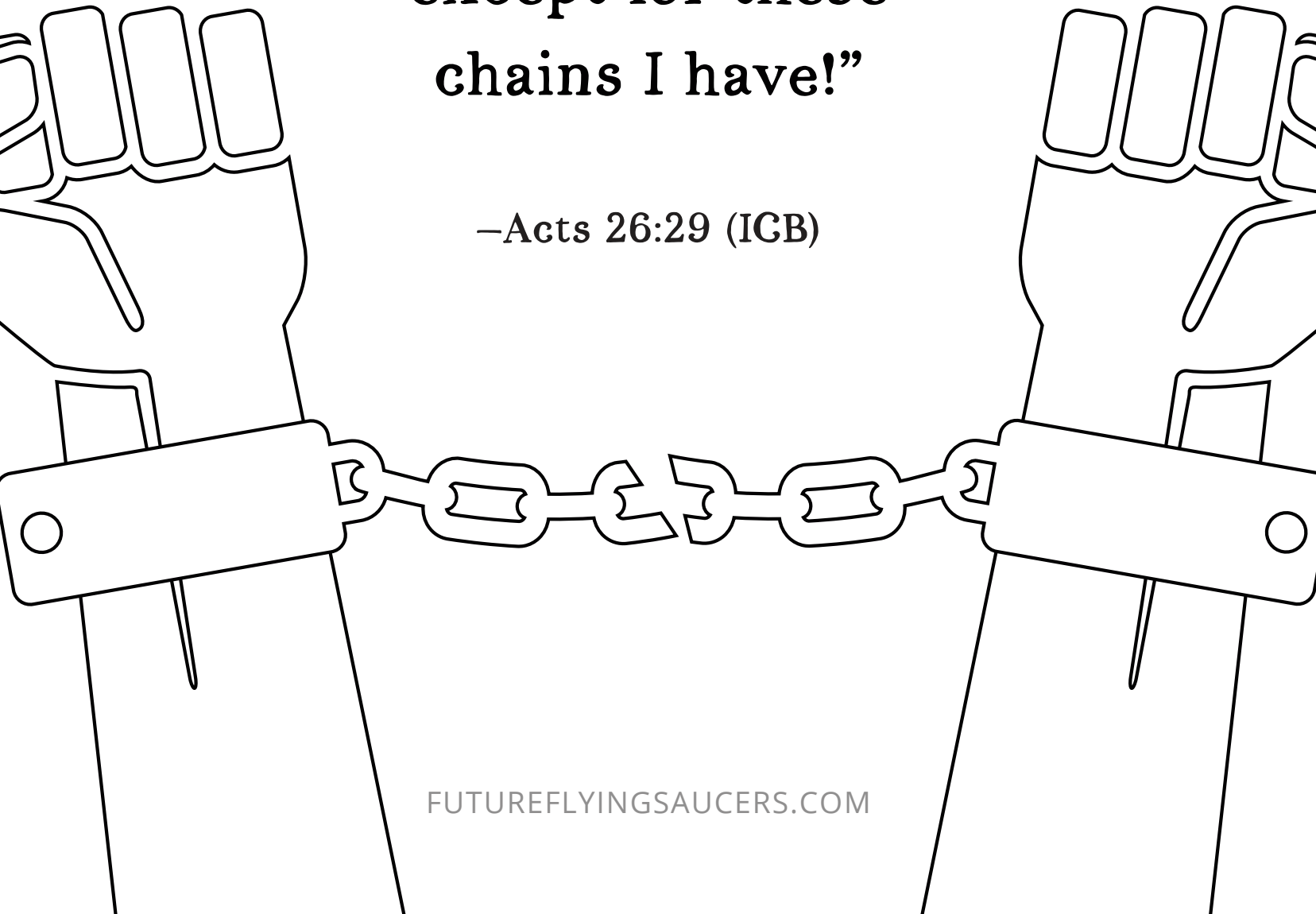
Paul said,

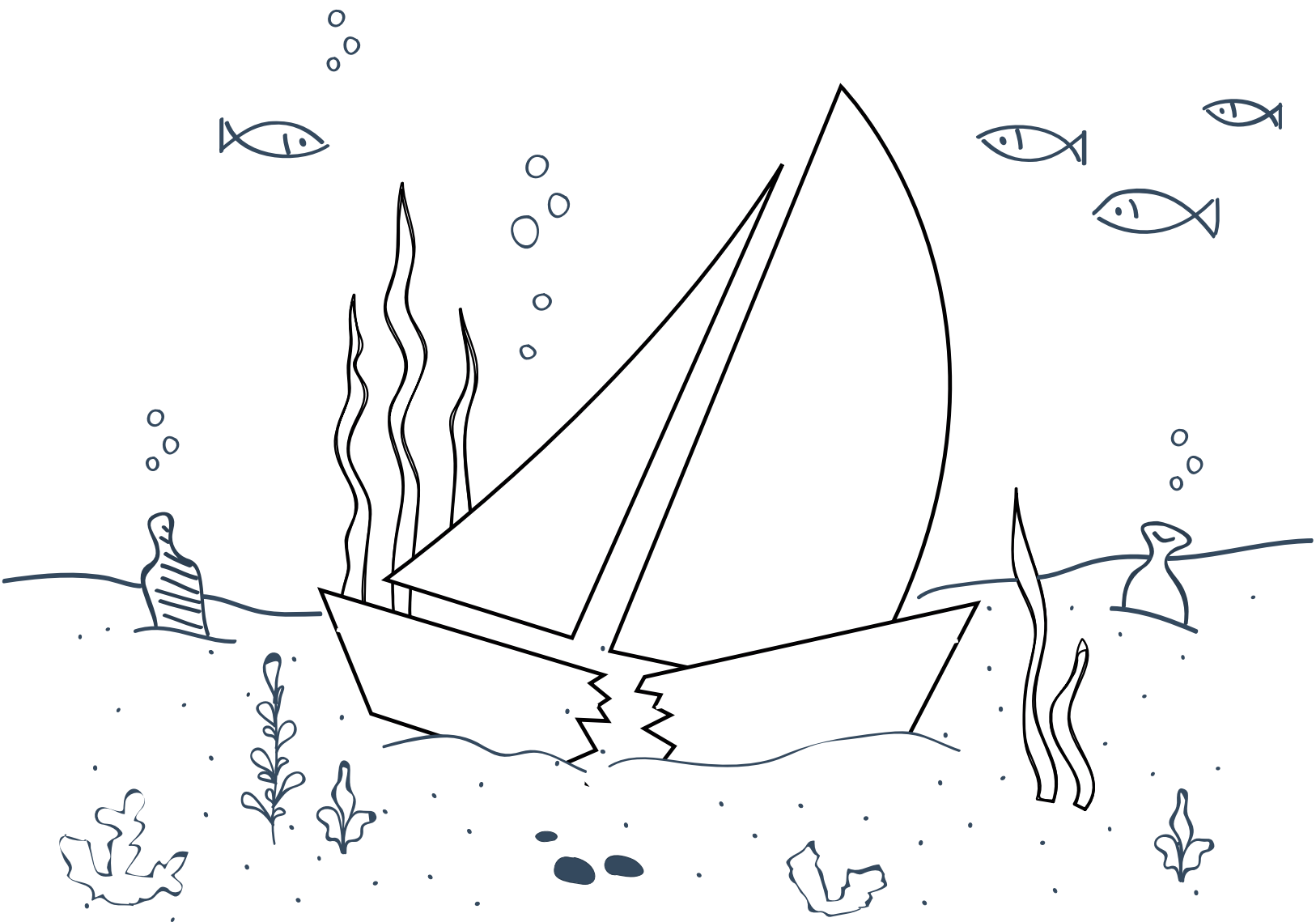

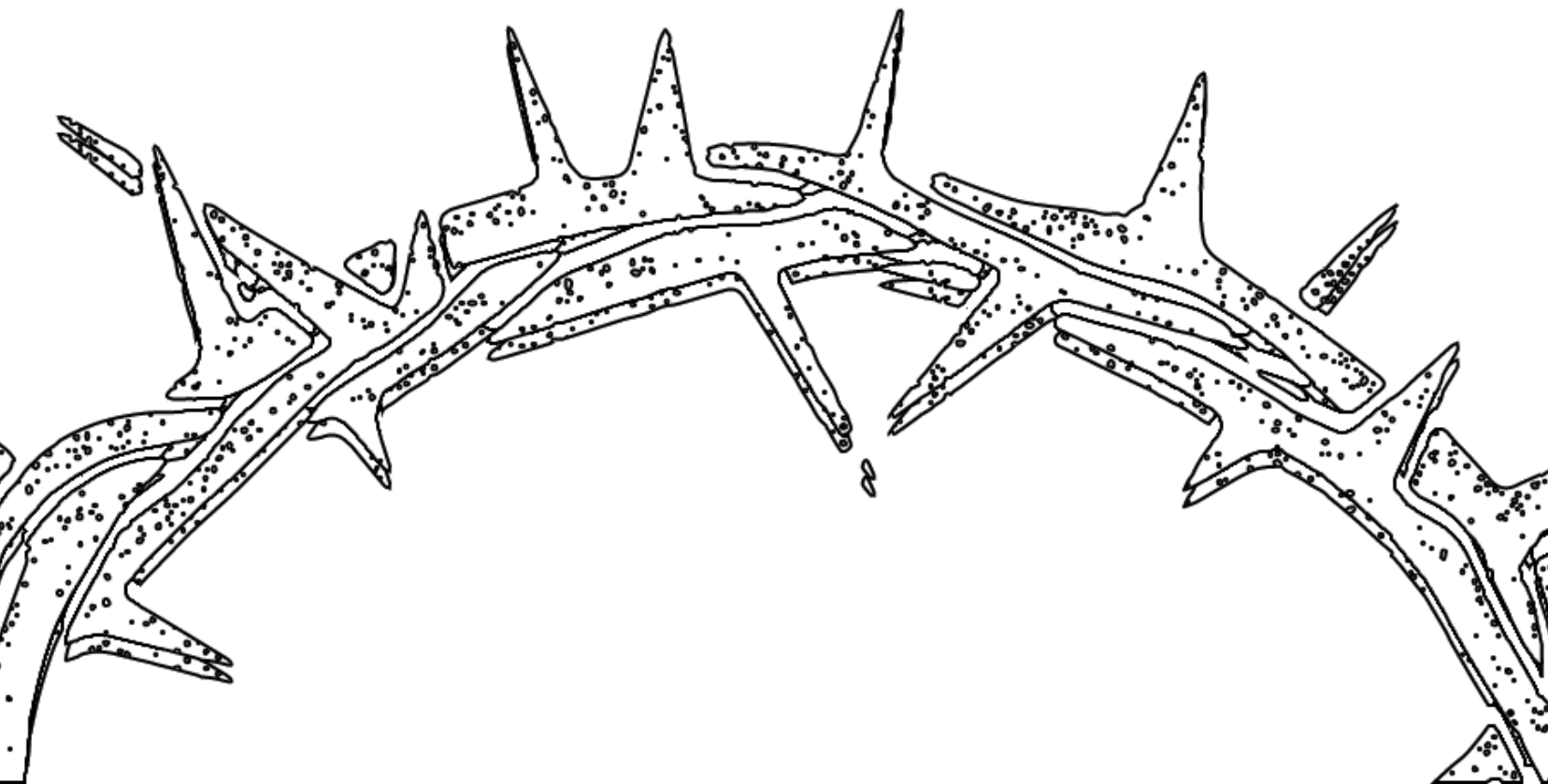
